mechanisms, such as the filter, and  
other areas subject to damage, with  
some type of insulation.*

# May 1st-May 8th

The following issues were discussed during the March Town Council meeting. Town residents with questions, concerns, or those wishing to obtain additional information are encouraged to phone the Town Hall or contact a member of the Town Council.

### **The Town Council:**

- Appointed Monte Aldridge, Angie Blackburn & David Peterson to a term on the Board of Adjustment.
- Reviewed proposed changes to an ordinance requiring the transfer of water rights to Annabella for annexations, as drafted and explained by the Planning Commission. The proposed changes include requiring two acre feet of underground water rights per acre of land annexed to Annabella Town; as opposed to the one acre foot required in the current ordinance. A public hearing will be advertised and held before the proposed changes are voted on by the Town Council. The public hearing will not be held in April because of the COVID-19 concern. Watch the next newsletter for more information.
- Discussed the culinary water improvement project. It was noted that once all automatic meters are installed, metered water use can be billed monthly. The Town Council will also be discussing winter water use in the upcoming months and as the project progresses.

## *Open Burning*

Sevier County is enforcing the procedures for open burning. An open burn permit application must be complete, and a valid permit issued by the county, prior to igniting open burn. Permits are issued in Sevier County until May 30th and can be filled out online at

- or search Utah Open Burning Permit
- or call 801-536-4000

Also, call dispatch before you burn so they are aware that it is controlled.



## **Backflow Prevention & Cross Connections**

A cross-connection is any connection between a public water system and any source or system containing non-potable water or other substances. In Annabella, the best example of a cross-connection would be the attachment of both culinary and irrigation connections in order to run a sprinkling system. Please note that before this can be done, prior arrangements must be made with the Maintenance Supervisor so the backflow protector can be inspected.
