Once mountain water has been used, a surcharge will be applied to irrigation connections to help compensate for the additional pumping expense.

The following issues were discussed during the June Town Council meeting. Town residents with questions, concerns, or those wishing to obtain additional information are encouraged to phone the Town Hall or contact a member of the Town Council.

A public hearing was held regarding a CIB application for a street improvement project. The application is for \$2,397,000 and would include nearly every street in town. The requested funding package from the Town Council is 100% grant 0% loan. The application will be reviewed by the CIB Board in July. Councilmember Kelvin Johns is overseeing the project.

A public hearing was held on the proposed 2020/2021 budget and the 2019/2020 amended budget.

The Town Council...

- ◆ Approved resolutions adopting the 2020/2021 budget and certified tax rate. Also, the amended 2019/2020 budget

Discussed 4th of July plans. Plans for a bike parade, outdoor patriotic video, flag raising ceremony and breakfast were originally made. Plans were later canceled due to the increase of COVID-19 cases in the area and concern for the safety and health of at-risk citizens.

Utility Bill

The new radio-read meter system makes it possible for monthly water meter readings. This water bill (and those going forward) will be for monthly water use, rather than every other month. Overages are billed after 10,000 gallons per month.

The water portion of next months utility bill will also include the annual 2% rate increase that was approved last year and was suggested by the Rural Water Association & our auditors. The increase will be 68 cents and increase the culinary water fee from \$33.89 to \$34.57.
