## Dog Clinic

Saturday, February 13th,  
from 10 a.m.- Noon

at the old Town Hall (90 North Main)

Dr. Johnson of the Richfield Veterinary Clinic will provide rabies and parvo vaccinations on Saturday, February 13th from 10 a.m.-Noon. Dogs are required to be current on their rabies vaccination for licensing; the parvo vaccination is optional and for the health of the dog. Dog owners will also be able to license and register their dog(s) with the Town during the clinic.

If your dog is current on their rabies vaccination, you may obtain your dog license at the Town Office during business hours. Or, if you prefer, you can call the office and we can add the dog licensing fee to your utility bill and mail the tag and license to you. You can also mail your payment, call and pay with credit/debit card, or leave a payment in the drop box.

Licensing fees are \$10.00 for spayed or neutered dogs and \$35.00 for unaltered dogs. Kennel licenses/fees and Conditional Use Permits are required for individuals owning three or more dogs.

Dog licenses not obtained by March 1st will be subject to a late fee of \$25.00 per dog.

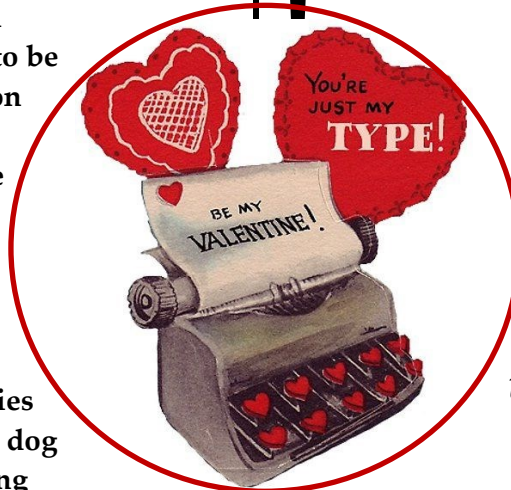

<b>Senior (62+)</b>	<b>\$5 per month</b>
<b>Single:</b>	<b>\$7.50 per month</b>
<b>Family:</b>	<b>\$12.50 per month</b>

**Please remember:**

***Youth under 14 years of age are not allowed in the exercise room, but may use the recreation room if accompanied by an adult.***

# ANIMAL CONTROL

Dogs are not permitted to run at large in Annabella. They must be appropriately confined at all times, either by a leash when off the property, or other means to keep them within an owner's property.

If you are having any concerns with dogs in your neighborhood, a photo or video of the dog & violation is enough proof for the animal control officer. The owner will first receive a warning and after the second citation in a 12 month period, the dog can be removed from the county.
