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Pressurized Irrigation

The pressurized irrigation will be turned off the morning of

Friday, October 1st

Once water is shut off, the valves will be drained. In order to avoid freezing during the winter months, you are encouraged to ensure that all lines on your property are drained. We also ask that all valves and taps are in the "OFF" position to avoid problems next spring when water is turned back in to the system.



Watch for reminders to be posted at the Post Office.
