The following issues were discussed during the June Town Council meeting. Town residents with questions, concerns, or those wishing to obtain additional information are encouraged to phone the Town Hall or contact a member of the Town Council.

- ◆ A public hearing was held on the proposed 2022/2023 budget and the 2021/2022 amended budget.

The Town Council...

- ◆ Approved resolutions adopting the 2022/2023 budget and certified tax rate. Also, the amended 2021/2022 budget.
- ◆ Discussed upcoming 4th of July activities and assignments.
 - ◆ Discussed cemetery maintenance and safety.
 - ◆ Considered options for purchasing new exercise room equipment.

White's Sanitation

Has added an additional 25 cent fuel surcharge to their garbage pickup fee. The increase is included on this statement for June's garbage pickup service.

The water portion of next months bill will include the annual 2% rate increase, as suggested by the Rural Water Association & our auditors. The increase will be 71 cents (from \$35.26 to \$35.97 for the 10,000 gallons base water rate).

Cemetery Policy

A note from the Town Council:

As much as we sympathize with wanting to memorialize loved ones that have passed away, leaving decorations and knick-knacks on graves year round is a safety concern for Town employees as they mow and edge around the headstones.

Annabella Cemetery Policy states:

Artificial decorations will not be allowed on sodded areas from April 1st to October 31st except during the Memorial Day holiday, with the exception that flowers may be placed in permanent containers on above the ground level monuments.

Baskets, boxes, pots, jars, cans, wires, bottles, knick-knacks, fences, etc. shall not be permitted on sodded covered areas except during the Memorial Day holiday. Any items placed on these areas are subject to removal as needed to perform on-going maintenance of the cemetery.

Again, we as a Town Council, we realize that some may like to leave items on graves year round, and have done so in the past, however; **they do impact safety and must be removed.**

Please note that maintenance workers will be removing the decorations from the cemetery that are not in a permanent container (cast into the concrete foundation of the monument), beginning July 18th.

Please remove any baskets, boxes, pots, jars, nick knacks, etc. that you would like to keep before July 18th.
