Dog Licenses Due

Thank you to the many residents who attended the dog clinic and who have licensed their dogs.

Dog licensing is important because it helps to ensure that the dogs in Town are properly vaccinated. Licensed dogs also have a better chance of being returned to their owner if lost.

Please note that a \$25 fine (per dog) will be added to each dog licensed after March 1st.

A Note from the Maintenance Dept.

The maintenance department will begin removing decorations from the sodded areas of the cemetery beginning April 1st.

Examples of items that will be removed include: baskets, solar lights, boxes, pots, jars, cans, wires, bottles, knick-knacks. etc. (anything that hinders mowing/edging and is not part of the permanent headstone).

Please remember that the cemetery policy does not allow decorations on sodded areas of the cemetery from April 1st-October 31st, with the exception of the Memorial Day holiday.

Annabella's Annual Water Quality Report



The Annual Water Quality Report, or Consumer Confidence Report, is a report required by the Safe Drinking Water Act. The report provides information on the quality of Annabella's drinking water and a summary of all of the testing on the culinary water system during the previous calendar year.

Annabella's Water Quality Report is available to view on the Town's website.

Building Permit Process:

A building permit is required for any structure that is larger than 120 sq. ft. If the structure is smaller than 120 sq. ft. and has plumbing or electrical, a building permit is also required.

Permits are available at the:

- Town Office
- Town Website
- Sevier County Building Department

Permits require the signatures of two Planning Commission members. Once signatures are obtained, the building permit is taken to the Sevier County Building Department, where fees are then calculated and paid.

Burn Permits

Permits for open burning are being issued beginning March 1st (this sometimes changes/updates, so please check air.utah.gov to confirm).

An open burn permit must be complete prior to igniting open burn. Permits are issued in Sevier County until May 23rd and can be filled out online at
